## **2019 Season review**

As you will all be aware earning my tour card was a lifelong dream, however I wanted to make sure that I continued to live this dream into 2020 and beyond.

Having battled hard all season I found myself needing a good week in the the season's final event in Kenya, the support I received from everyone at the club really made me feel confident going into the week. I finished the week in Tied 22<sup>nd</sup> to ensure I kept my card for the 2020 season finishing 63<sup>rd</sup> in the Order of Merit.

With this I also managed to finish as the 7<sup>th</sup> best rookie for the year, competing for the highest rookie alongside some great players including members of the 2019 winning Solheim cup team and even this year's Order of Merit winner.

The season highlight for me was finishing 8<sup>th</sup> in Morocco earlier in the year, this after being +4 for the first 27 holes of the tournament. it certainly felt like a turning point and pushed me on in the following events.

## **Looking ahead to 2020**

As many of you will have seen and experienced it has been extremely difficult to get any real practice in this winter, fortunately I have been lucky enough to use the great practice facilities that the golf club and Growing golf have to offer. They really are second to none.

I am looking to set off to Spain for some warm weather training in the coming weeks before jetting off to Australia to begin the 2020 season, not so European but exciting never the less.

The Ladies European Tour have now announced a partnership with the LPGA, a 3-year contract including 1.5 million pounds worth of prize money to be spread over a number of new tournaments added to the schedule. Certainly, a very positive time to be amongst the LET.

The 2020 schedule now has a confirmed 22 tournaments from Australia to the Middle East and even Asia.
